



Application for an Apprentice Judge GSDL-WB

Applicants wishing to become GSDL-WDG Apprentice Judges must meet the following qualifying criteria:

- A minimum of three years consecutive membership of the GSDL-WDG
- Shall have trained and qualified one dog from BH to Schutzhund 3 / IPO3 and another dog from BH to Schutzhund 1/ IPO1

If the Apprentice Judge application is accepted by the GSDL-WDG Committee, the Apprentice Judge will be required to carry out the following:

- A minimum of five (5) apprenticeships under the supervision of foreign judges from any internationally recognised association,
- A minimum of three (3) apprenticeships under GSDL WDG Judges.
- A minimum of fifty (50) dogs shall be judged. BH entries do not count towards this total.
- Final apprenticeship must be with an approved WUSV Teaching Judge with that judge confirming to the GSDL-WDG Committee the suitability or otherwise of that Apprentice Judge
